The princely state of Rewa was founded by the Baghel Rajputs around 1400 AD and was chosen as the capital of Vindhya Pradesh. Post independence, it continues to be an important administrative headquarters of the Rewa, Satna and Sidhi divisions.

Situated in the northeastern part of MP, Rewa is well connected to nearby and other major cities through rail and road. The nearest airports are at Prayag, Varanasi, Khajuraho, Jabalpur and Bhopal.

Blessed with immense natural beauty, Rewa was home to Mohan-the world's first white tiger. The lineage of these rare white tigers continues to thrive here even today and they can be seen at the Mukundpur White Tiger Safari situated on the outskirts of Rewa. The city is surrounded by many picturesque waterfalls like Keoti, Chachai, Purva and Bahuti to name a few. These high and breathtakingly beautiful waterfalls are definitely a sight for sore eyes. Besides these, ancient monuments like the Buddhist Stupa of the Mauryan age at Deur Kothar and the 35 feet long reclining Bhairav Baba statue sculpted out from a single stone are part of Rewa's glorious heritage. The Baghela museum, Govindgarh lake palace and Rani Talab temple are other important and must-visit tourist destinations.

Though it seems small and noisy like any other Indian town, yet Rewa offers an incredible mix of serene natural beauty, rich historical treasure and diverse cultural heritage.
